

STUDENT & ALUMNI DINNER CLUB – FAQs

What is the Dinner Club?

Lehigh University's Student & Alumni Dinner Club is an opportunity for Lehigh alumni, faculty, and staff to host a group of current students at their home for a meal and conversation about life at Lehigh, classes, careers and other various topics of interest.

Who is involved with the Dinner Club?

- Involved and dedicated Lehigh University alumni, faculty, and staff who are looking for a way to interact, casually, with some of Lehigh's best current students.
- Current Lehigh University students who are committed to learning more about Lehigh and its alumni, faculty, and staff.

When is the Dinner Club?

Each host volunteer is asked to host a group of students for dinner **one** night during the provided range of dates: **October 18 through November 1**. Hosts will be asked to provide their preferred date, time and location. The Alumni Association will market the available dates to the students, and students will sign up online on a first-come, first-served basis. Dinners vary in length of time, but commonly range from two to three hours.

Why should I participate in the Dinner Club?

The Dinner Club provides alumni, faculty, and staff with the opportunity to give back to Lehigh University and its students in a way that will directly impact the students with whom they interact – all from the comfort of their own home. The Dinner Club allows alumni, faculty, and staff to learn about Lehigh today, as well as other ways they can be involved with the future successes of the university.

Where does the Dinner Club meet?

Meals can be hosted from the comfort of the home. Students will arrive together at the residence for food, conversation and fun! Hosts also have the option to have a meal elsewhere (such as a park, restaurant, etc.), if they so choose.

How do I sign up for the Dinner Club?

This is to allow for the best safety and comfort among all participants.*
